

Clerk's Report

Sparkx finally replaced the storm-damaged junction box by the bus stop – and sent the bill.

I have been looking into the possibility of having the road through the village designated as not suitable for lorries. The parish may need to put forward a proposal to the Bucks Council commissioning team including alternative routes, and we may need to provide a feasibility study. Further details elsewhere in the meeting.

I put in the request to Fix my Street about having the approaches to the A421 included on the winter gritting route, which has been forwarded to the Winter Maintenance Team.

Ecological survey on brook was carried out starting 04/06 – next step in the process for repairing the embankment. Solar farm VUU has been completed & countersigned.

The Annual Parish meeting was held on 28th May. There were 21 attendees and a variety of village groups spoke about their activities.

Thanks to Chris Hooper for rubbing down the benches in the Garden of Peace & to the resident who assisted with rubbing down & re-oiling the noticeboard.
